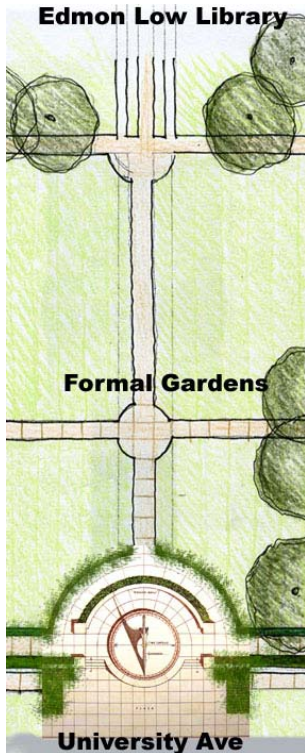

The Greek Centennial Sundial at OSU

The pinnacle of the Greek Centennial will be the construction of a **Greek Centennial Sundial** on the prestigious Library axis of the OSU Master Plan—a monument on par with symbols of International, Military and Athletic traditions at OSU.

Each of the 50 Greek organizations from OSU's past century will be incised on the circumference of the dial. A gleaming stainless gnomon will rise sixteen feet from the face in perfect alignment with the Library tower. Steps, benches and landscaping will create a meeting place for student organizations, a venue for outdoor concerts, an extension of the Atherton Hotel for weddings or receptions and a photo highlight for families returning to campus and young men and women considering OSU Greek Life.

But this gift from the Greek community cannot happen without the financial support of Greek chapters and members.
