### Century of Significance

*In 1908, a group of dancers and singers at Oklahoma A&M adopted the name Delta Sigma to form the first Greek society on campus. That first fraternity became Gamma Lambda chapter of Beta Theta Pi. They were joined in 1912 by the first sorority, Kappa Delta.*

And so began a century of service and leadership that left an indelible mark on the campus and on the lives of hundreds of thousands of members of the OSU Greek community.

Today 30 of the 50 Greek organizations established at OSU continue. In 2008 members will reunite to recognize the value of the Greek experience and to present the campus with a permanent monument to recognize a century of contributions by Greek men and women to OSU.
