Transfer	Transfer Nonresident Achievement Scholarship (Nonresidents only)	The Transfer Nonresident Achievement Scholarship is renewable for up to two years with a 3.0 cumulative college GPA. Recipients must earn a minimum of 28 credit hours each year (fall/spring). No academic area of emphasis required.	Up to \$5,000 per year	24+ semester hours, 3.25 GPA
Legacy	Alumni Legacy Scholarship (Nonresidents only)	Nonresident tuition scholarship. Recipients must pay resident tuition and any nonresident tuition remaining after the scholarship is applied. Freshman award renewable up to 4 years. Transfer award duration varies. Renewable with 3.00 cumulative graduation/retention GPA and 28 hours earned each year.	Up to \$5,000 per year	Child/grandchild of OSU alumnus who earned a bachelor's degree or higher at OSU. Qualifying parent/grandparent alumnus must have graduated before student attends OSU.
